

Text of the Motions Made and Passed by Members During the Member Comment Period

Judi LaCava-Goldkamp: I would like to make the motion to compel the board to re-instate the previous rule for members to vote individually, and not for merely a slate of candidates, and to have all members ratify this at the next board meeting or at a specially called meeting to be voted on by the entire membership of the CO-OP.

Karl Goldkamp: I make the motion to compel the board to declare this election invalid on the grounds that they were not carried out according to the bylaws of the Co-op that were in effect at the time of the announcement of this election.

Since the bylaws were changed specifically to accommodate this slate of candidates only four days ago, and such changes were not approved by the board or the members of the Co-op, we compel the board to declare this election null and void on behalf of the entire membership of this Co-op.

Furthermore I compel the board to schedule a 'special meeting' that we requested by the petition previously submitted to this board, in which to hold a bonified election for members of the board of Fiddleheads.

Karl Goldkamp: I make the motion to compel the board to amend Bylaw section 12.1 to permit bylaw amendments to be made only by a majority vote at a membership meeting, and to present such amendment to a vote at a following meeting of members to be called within two months, at which time such amendment will be subject to further amendment by members.

Additionally, I make a motion to compel the board to distribute to all members a copy of the bylaws as they exist at the date of this meeting.

Bob Stuller: I make a motion to compel the board to create an independent, online means of interactive communication open to all members, and to compel the board to publish a newsletter at a frequency not less than quarterly, allocating funds for the purpose if necessary.
